Report on fulfilling the FOIA request submitted by Joe Stutler 6/3/2016 (See Below)

Work on the SAVIN MFDs.

- On Monday 6/6/2016 I stopped by the Auditor's Office and retrieved the logs from both SAVIN MFDs in that area.
- The SAVIN in the GIS office showed scanned to email documents starting on 6/3/2016 at 5:24PM (this was the device in question).
- The SAVIN in the Elections Office showed scanned documents starting on 4/8/2016 4:38PM.
- Upon retrieving these logs, the scanner deletes the existing log and starts a new log.

Conversation with Linn County IT Mgmt:

- I showed my report findings to management and offered to, and was granted permission to relay this information to Mr. Stutler.

Conversation with Mr. Stutler:

- In this conversation I was very careful to explain what the evidence showed. I stressed that in my explanation I did not wish to infer any assumption of the state of the evidence and I was reassured that Mr. Stutler understood my intentions on the information delivery.
- I still retain the hard copies of the SAVIN log reports.

Follow-up request from Mr. Stutler:

- Mr. Stutler would like to know if there are any email logs showing data coming from the SAVIN in the GIS office bearing the Filename 20160602112406047.pdf as shown in his request. He would also like to know to whom this was sent.

- I asked that we check to make sure we are within the scope of the FOIA request.
- We checked the writing in the request and he feels this is within the scope as the request is written.
- I stated that I would follow-up with Linn County IT Management to ensure we are within the guidelines.
- He understood and wanted to reassure us that both he and Linn County want to do this.

Follow-up Conversation with Linn County IT Mgmt:

- Spoke with IT Mgmt and conveyed Mr. Stutler's request for more complete email scan.
- Mgmt agreed that it was within the scope of the request.

I am currently working with the network team to investigate that area of data.
